School Annual Education Report (AER) Cover Letter

Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2021-22 educational progress for Mayville Middle & High School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. Please note that the NAEP academic data are displayed at the state level only.

For the school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was identified as a **"HAS NOT BEEN GIVEN ONE OF THESE LABELS"**.

MME/PSAT/SAT assessment data shows that we are below the state average in every subject area. We identified gaps in the economically disadvantaged subgroup. The content areas in which the gap was widest were Math & Language Arts. After looking at our data we discovered that additional work needs to be done in all core subject areas, data needs to be continually analyzed and used, and the school improvement plan needs to be a living document and process. State law requires that we also report additional information.

Mayville Middle & High School is the only Middle & High School within Mayville Community Schools. It houses students in grades 6-12. Mayville Middle & High School offers a broad-based curriculum with numerous options for all students. Mayville Community Schools participates in the Schools-of-Choice enrollment program to include out-of-district students.

Process for Assigning Students to Each School: Students in grades kindergarten through fifth enrolled at Mayville Community Schools are assigned to Mayville Elementary School. The students that are in grades sixth through twelfth are assigned to Mayville Middle & High School. We ensure equitable learning environments for students who are enrolled in either building in our school district.

All students have access to programs offered by the district, the elementary school, or the Middle & High School.

School Improvement: The Board of Education authorizes and supports the formation of building level school improvement committees at each building within the district. Based on information gathered throughout the school year, the School Improvement Team looks at revising, eliminating or evolving current goals for the following year. Information gathered includes standardized test scores analysis, teacher observation, information gathered through survey or other devices for parent/student input. School Improvement is a continuous process at Mayville High School. Building School Improvement Plans are reviewed annually and submitted to the State. Our **Goals** are that Middle & High School students will increase their proficiency in Reading, Mathematics and Writing and develop self-awareness, self-management skills to achieve school and life success.

Specialized Schools: Mayville Community Schools offers Learning Options, an alternative high school program that offers students a second chance for different levels of success by creating an environment for individual learning styles through strong student teacher relationships. The program provides students with the skills necessary for life after high school. Through hard work, determination, and teamwork students learn to trust themselves, and one another, while working towards personal goals. Mayville Community Schools also provides educational programs, services and support to certified special education students throughout the District.

Description of Each School: Mayville Elementary School is a public school with approximately 275 students. It is the only elementary building in the district, housing kindergarten through fifth grade. Sixth through twelfth grades are housed in our middle and high school buildings. Each student has an assigned chromebook. There are two computer labs in our building. Our building has a gymnasium, cafeteria, media center/library, band/music room and auditorium.

Access to the Core Curriculum: Mayville Community Schools Community Schools implements a core curriculum which covers all grades, kindergarten through twelve, and describes what a student will know and be able to do for each subject area. All Mayville curriculum is based upon the National Common Core curriculum, Michigan Grade Level Content Standards and Michigan Merit Curriculum Standards.

Local Assessment Data: At Mayville Middle & High School, we use a variety of qualitative and quantitative methods (in addition to the MME) to assess the whole student. Students are assessed both formally and informally in all classes using a variety of instruments including projects, performance and technology based presentations. Common assessments in mathematics, language arts, science and social studies are administered to all students.

Parent/Teacher Conference Data: We had 32% of our students represented this year at our fall Parent/Teacher Conferences. However, we allowed any student with a C or below for parents to make contacts with teachers.

We at Mayville Middle & High School continually strive to provide up-to-date and quality curriculum and education for our students.
