Dear Parents and Staff Members:

We received confirmation that an Elementary staff member has tested positive for COVID-19. The individual last worked on Friday, January 15th. District officials, in coordination with the Tuscola and Lapeer County Health Department, helped identify anyone on our campus who had been in close contact (within six feet for more than 15 minutes) with the employee. Fortunately, the person was not in contact with any employee or students while having symptoms.

The District will continue to cooperate with the Tuscola and Lapeer County Health Department to assist in contact tracing and notification if there are additional positive school-associated cases. The District will maintain strict enforcement of health and safety guidelines in order to limit transmission of COVID-19.

We ask that all parents check students for symptoms daily prior to sending them to school. Any student or staff member exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 should stay home. COVID-19 symptoms include fever, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, and diarrhea.
