Dear Parents, Students and Staff Members:

We received confirmation that an employee has tested positive for COVID-19. The individual last worked on Monday, November 23rd. District officials, in coordination with the Tuscola County Health Department, have identified anyone on our campus who had been in close contact (within six feet for more than 15 minutes) with the employee. Those individuals have been contacted directly.

The District will continue to cooperate with the Tuscola County Health Department to assist in contact tracing and notification if there are additional positive school-associated cases. The District will maintain strict enforcement of health and safety guidelines in order to limit transmission of COVID-19.

We ask that all parents check students for symptoms daily prior to sending them to school. Any student or staff member exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 should stay home. COVID-19 symptoms include fever, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, and diarrhea.

Fortunately, we did not have school on Wednesday, November 25th and scheduled our custodial group to complete a **“deep clean”** of all buildings on campus to maintain a healthy and safe environment.
