We were notified today that we now have three students in grades 6-12 that have tested positive for COVID-19 this week. The students were last present at Mayville Middle & High School on Friday, March 19th. All staff and students, who may have had close contact, within 6 feet for 15 minutes with the affected students have been notified and asked to begin the quarantine period.

For health and safety reasons and the concern for the increased number of students testing positive and being quarantined at Mayville Middle & High School. Students in grades 6-12 will be going to remote learning for the rest of this week starting on Wednesday, March 24th. Students will resume in person learning after spring break on Monday, April 5th.

Reminder, students must check in each day between 8am and 3pm for attendance and two way communications for attendance. They must check their google classroom daily and can attend the teachers google meet office hours, phone communication, email or submit an assignment for the two way communication.

K-5 students will remain in person at this time!
