About Mayville Area Share Shop

The Mayville Area Share Shop is a 501(c)3 organization functioning under the State of Michigan guidelines. The purpose of the Mayville Area Share Shop is to respond to the needs of families in our area by coordinating the efforts of churches and civic organizations, by providing clothing, emergency food, utility assistance, and household items, as well as acting as a referral and educational service and directing our excess to other agencies and communities.

Guidelines

Mayville Area Share Shop will award one (1) education scholarship in the amount of \$1000.00 to a senior attending high school in the town of Mayville, Michigan where the Mayville Area Share Shop has a physical presence in serving the community.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- **Seeking graduating seniors with a record of volunteerism** in the community in non-school sponsored activities or exemplary participation in extracurricular school activities.
- **Applicants must plan to attend a college, technical or trade school** for further advancements in education.
- Scholarship will be awarded with first consideration based on the needs of the applicant and their volunteerism, and quality of completed application.
- Scholarship funds can be used toward tuition or book expenses incurred in the twelve-month period following high school graduation.
- It will be the student's responsibility to submit to the Mayville Area Share Shop any appropriate information for the scholarship to be paid directly to the educational institution.
- Applicants must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor on their application attesting they are qualified for this scholarship program. **Mayville Area Share Shop suggests that the high school present this opportunity to the strongest applicants that match this program's guidelines.**
- Completed applications are to be received by the committee by the 3rd Friday of March. Late applications are not accepted.
- Applications shall be delivered to the Mayville Area Share Shop Scholarship Committee whose address is P.O. Box 54; Mayville, MI 48744.
- Applications will be reviewed and recipient(s) selected by a committee consisting of volunteers of the Mayville Area Share Shop.
